Hi, my name is Christopher Baker and my wife Tori and I live at 525 Norton St in Long Boat Key. We were asked to report our flooding experience during Hurricane Debbie.

- 1. How deep was the water in your house? No water entered our home
- 2. How deep was it in your garage? Approximately 1 inch of water flooded our garage
- 3. How long was water over the road in front of your driveway? Water covered the road infront of our home for approximately 3 days
- 4. If you used sandbags or a flood barrier, and water did not enter the house, how high was the water above the level of your floors? N/A
- 5. If water did not enter the house or garage, how close did it get, and how deep was it in the yard at the deepest point?

Our street and driveway flood with nearly every heavy rain. I am born and raised in Florida and have never dealt with such a poor drainage system. As recent new owners we are very concerned about our new investment with such water intrusion on a Cat 1 hurricane. We are hopeful for your help in an expedited process to improve this problem.
