

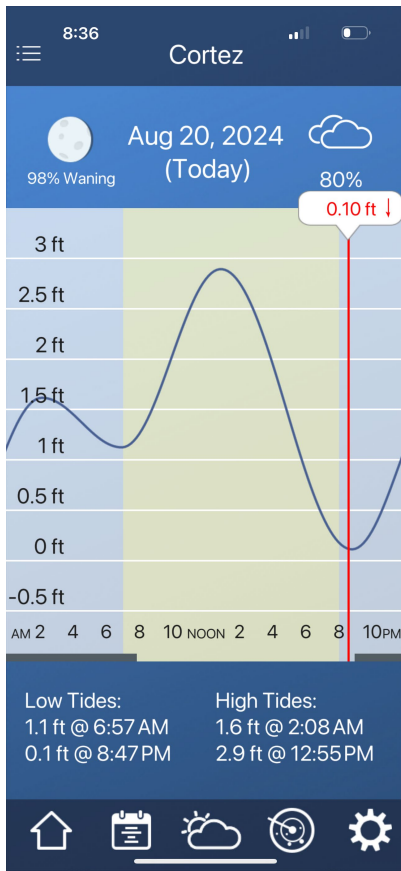

Despite the light rainfall, the single road designed to handle water drainage was completely overwhelmed, leaving the road submerged and entirely impassable to us. I've attached a picture of the street along with today's live tide chart. The chart clearly shows on high tide that could explain the standing water, making the situation even more alarming. This is the worst flooding I've ever seen here, especially under such favorable conditions with the low tides. The frequency and severity of these floods have increased dramatically, leading me to believe there's a serious issue with our current drainage system over the canal. This situation is untenable, and the safety and accessibility of our neighborhood are at risk. This is just another attempt to help the forward progress of the new plan.
