Hi there, saw your article in the Observer and thought I would let you know about our flooding.

We live at 600 Russell St in the Village. Our yard flooded all the way up to our front walkway. At the bottom of our driveway, the water stood at 2.5' during high tide. We have a storm grate directly in front of our house, and one at the top of the street. These were full at low tide.

The canal along Longboat Dr N was overflowing completely over the yards and into the street at Longboat Dr N. The alley was underwater, and this flowed into our backyard, standing about 1' deep. Water never reached our lanai. Probably the worst part are the mosquitos which are very thick in our yard/neighborhood.

I manage the Wicker Inn at 5581 GOM. We had no flooding or any issues. No storm damage.
