All Public to be Heard comments will be taken at the beginning of the meeting for both Agenda and Non-Agenda items.

For the April 14, 2020, meeting, please use the meeting link <https://zoom.us/j/359673133> to virtually attend and watch the meeting by computer, tablet, or smartphone. Those whom have pre-registered to speak, will be called upon and the Town's 3-minute time limit will be enforced. If joining from a tablet or smartphone, you will need to download the free Zoom app from your device's app store. If joining from a computer, your computer will automatically download and install (if needed) the Zoom program. If you currently have Zoom installed on your computer, tablet, or smartphone, you may join the meeting by entering the meeting ID 359 673 133. If not specifically requested within the written comments, all other written comments received by the deadline will be distributed to the Committee members prior to the start of the meeting. Time limits will be enforced for written comments that are read into the record, so all written comments must be limited to 3 minutes.
